

SUGGESTED USE RESTRICTIONS

RE:

RIVERSIDE VILLAGE GREENBELT

1. Public access to and use of the Greenbelt within or adjacent to Riverside Village shall be limited and restricted to pedestrian foot traffic only. No bicycles or motorized conveyances shall be permitted.
2. The Greenbelt area shall be available for public access and use during daylight hours only.
3. Access by the public from the Greenbelt area onto, over, along and across abutting private property shall be prohibited.
4. Public use of the Greenbelt area for purposes which results in accumulation of trash, garbage, litter or debris or which results in damage or destruction of the improvements constructed thereon shall be prohibited.
5. The following activities shall be prohibited by any person within the Greenbelt area, the use of the Greenbelt area by the public to be limited to those activities involved in the passive enjoyment of nature:
 - (a) The willful marking, defacing, disfiguring, injuring, displacing, removing or otherwise damaging any of the improvements, landscaping or any portions of the Greenbelt area.
 - (b) The placing, pasting, gluing, tacking, installing, painting, inscribing or in any way affixing or attaching of any sign, plaque, advertisement, notice or placard or inscription of any kind, whether temporary or permanent, except for such signs, notices or placards placed within the Greenbelt area for public notification or direction in connection with the use thereof by the public.
 - (c) The damaging, cutting, carving, transplanting or removing of any tree, plant or other landscaping, including the picking of flowers or seeds of any tree or plant in the Greenbelt area.
 - (d) The attaching of any rope, wire or other contrivance to any tree or plant within the Greenbelt area.

- (e) The hunting, molesting, harming, frightening, removing, killing, trapping, chasing, teasing, annoying, shooting or throwing missiles at any animal, reptile, fish or bird, or the eggs or nest or the young of the same, provided that access to the Boise River for fishing with rod and reel shall be permitted so long as public safety is not endangered thereby.
- (f) The setting up of a tent, shack or other temporary shelter for the purpose of camping.
- (g) The playing of games or sports involving thrown or otherwise propelled objects such as stones, arrows, balls or other objects.
- (h) The riding, walking or grazing of a horse or other similar animal.
- (i) The allowing of a dog or other similar domestic animal to enter upon or remain within the Greenbelt area.
- (j) The consumption, possession, sale or use of any alcoholic beverage, narcotic or drug.
- (k) Any act or conduct which endangers the safety, health or welfare of any other person or property.
- (l) The solicitation or accosting of other persons for the purpose of begging or soliciting alms.
- (m) The operation of radios, phonographs, tape recorders or other loud speakers and/or sound amplification devices except when used with individual earphones.
- (n) The sale or display for sale of any article or thing or the distribution, leaving or throwing of any advertising material such as handbills, circulars or the like or otherwise distributing for advertising purposes any goods or wares.
- (o) The construction or erection of any building or structure of whatever kind, whether permanent or temporary in character, or the running or stringing of any public service utility, except as specifically allowed by the governmental entity having jurisdiction and control of the Greenbelt area.

- (p) The digging or disturbing of any portion of the Greenbelt area or in any other way injuring or impairing the natural beauty and usefulness of the Greenbelt area.
 - (q) The giving or offering, or attempting to give or offer to any animal, reptile, fish or bird, any tobacco, alcohol, narcotic, drug or other know noxious substance.
 - (r) The using, carrying or possessing of a firearm of any kind, or air rifle, spring gun, bow and arrow, slings or any other form of weapon potentially inimical to wildlife and/or dangerous to human safety, or any instrument that can be loaded with and fire blank cartridges or any kind of trapping device.
 - (s) The discharging, or having in possession, any fireworks.
 - (t) The prevention of any person from legally using the Greenbelt area or the interference with such use.
 - (u) The entering or remaining upon the Greenbelt area other than during daylight hours.
 - (v) The using, carrying or being in the possession of any beverage container made of glass.
 - (w) The discarding, placing, leaving or dumping of any trash, garbage, litter or debris of any kind or nature.
 - (x) The endangering of the safety or health of any person by any conduct or act.
6. Persons utilizing the Greenbelt area, shall not park a motor vehicle, including a bicycle, motorcycle or other mechanical means of conveyance, on any private road or on any private property adjacent to or in the proximity of the Greenbelt area or on any public street or right-of-way where parking is prohibited.
